



16 – 19 TUITION FUND

The 16 – 19 tuition fund is a £96 million one-off fund, ring fenced for schools, colleges and other 1619 providers to support small group tuition for students in English, mathematics and other courses where learning has been disrupted due to the covid-19 outbreak.

Charters School has been allocated £1664 from this fund for small group tuition. Charters School will use this funding to support learners who did not achieve a grade 4 or above in English or Mathematics and will prioritise students with special educational needs and disabilities and those classified as disadvantaged students. This will be in addition to the planned programme of study hours already timetabled for the academic year 2020/21.
