- **Community:** students are taught what being part of a community means. This often links to the school community and the idea of 'Unity', linking to the school ethos.
- **Skills:** these periods link to the skills which students should be able to demonstrate, in particular their ability to function in school, the workplace and society. Often, these link to 'Excellence' in the school ethos.
- **PSHE:** students are required to cover important values or health-based topics which form part of the statutory requirement in all schools. These topics often link to the 'Respect' aspect of the school ethos.
- **Careers:** in these periods, students consider what they might do in the future. Careers guidance is a statutory requirement. These topics often link to the 'Excellence' aspect of the school ethos.
