



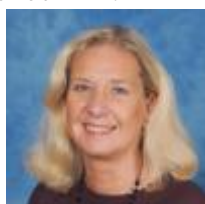
Dear Parent/Carer,

| Start of Term | The first day for year 8 students is Monday 6 September. |
| Tutor Rooms | I will write to the students to inform them which room they need to go to for their Tutor Group. |
| Start of the school day | A bell will ring at 8.25 am each morning so that students can make their way to their tutor rooms so that they can be lined up ready to be invited in to their tutor rooms at 8.30 am prompt. |
| Uniform/PE kit | All students should wear Winter uniform when they return in September. On days when there is a timetabled PE lesson, kit should be brought in separately and students will change in to their Charters PE kit in the changing rooms at the beginning of their PE lesson. |
